

Returning to OPCC? Review our covenant with one another :

Following the protocols set out by our OPCC Returning task force is more than just "obeying the rules." It's how we show that we care for the whole body of Christ, not just ourselves. By returning to OPCC for any reason, you are agreeing to a covenant of behaviors that is designed to extend God's compassionate care to all members, visitors, and community members.

Confirm you are free of symptoms and exposure.

If you are at risk of spreading COVID-19 because of symptoms, exposure to a case, an unknown test result, or your own positive diagnosis **worship from home**. When you enter the building (through the main / East doors), you will be asked a series of question to confirm that you are not a risk to those around you. Wear a mask the entire time you are at OPCC.

Masks prevent you from spreading the virus to others, and are one of the simplest ways to love your neighbor. Masks must be worn over the mouth *and* nose as long as you are at OPCC, indoors *or* outdoors. The only exception is when you are actively taking communion. If you cannot wear a mask for that length of time, please continue to worship from home. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you.

Practice social distancing.

Stay at least 6 feet away from those outside your household. We know you want to hug and shake hands. Simply put, PLEASE DON'T. Jesus should be able to lie down for a nap between you and the next person in the pew. Ushers / deacons will help remind you of this as pews are marked off to help keep us distanced.

Prepare yourself for things to be different.

Returning to OPCC does not mean returning to normal - we might never return to what was, and that's OK! It's OK to grieve that basic pieces of our worship, *like congregational singing, will be missing for now*. Beloved faces will be missing too. You may experience a variety of emotions from joy to grief to frustration as things will look different. Extend grace to yourself, the leadership, and your fellow congregation members. This is hard, but God is with us, wherever / however we worship.

Enter through the East doors, off Conser Street

So that you can check-in with our greeters, please plan to enter and exit through the main church doors off Conser street.

Record your attendance

No matter your reason for being in the building (worship or fellowship), please mark your attendance so that we can conduct CONTACT TRACING if we have a COVID-positive person in the building at a time when you were also at OPCC.

Use the bathroom before you arrive.

The bathrooms will be available for urgent needs, but because our bathrooms have limited ventilation, please plan to use the restroom at home before you arrive. If you need the restroom while here please observe the requirement that only one person use the restroom at a time, and keep a six-foot distance while waiting for the restroom in the hall.

If possible, continue to give electronically.

We will not pass the offering plates. A donations box will be provided for you to drop offering into as you enter the sanctuary, and we will continue to pray over any offering received, but if you are able to give online, that continues to be the safest (least contact for all) and easiest option.

Do not congregate inside

We know its hard to not greet one another, and to continue visiting with each other after the service is over, but we also know it is the safest. Please plan to arrive at OPCC shortly before we begin, and to depart as soon as we are done. Visiting is safest outside in the light of God's creation!



Please confirm the following truths about yourself / household prior to joining us in-person at Overland Park Christian Church

Please confirm that you and your household are free of COVID-19 symptoms for the last 48 hours. These may include:

- fever or chills
- cough
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fatigue
- muscle or body aches
- headache
- new loss of taste or smell
- sore throat
- congestion or runny nose
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea

Please confirm that you are NOT waiting for a COVID-19 test result

Please confirm that you have NOT been in close contact in the last 14 days with anyone who is known to have a *confirmed case* of COVID-19

Please confirm that you have NOT been in close contact in the last 14 days with anyone who has any *symptoms* consistent with COVID-19

Please confirm that you WILL follow the Overland Park Christian Covenant of behavior, as we care for the *whole* Body of Christ.
