As we maintain that covenant with our denomination, we will begin a six-week focus on the "Kindom of God, Within Us, Among Us," focusing on who we are as members of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Not only is it good to regularly center ourselves within our faith tradition, these six weeks will help us worship in-step with other Disciples of Christ congregations around the U.S. and Canada in preparation for our biennial meeting of the whole church called the General Assembly.

When the General Assembly meets in Louisville, KY, July 29-August 1, 2023, it will be the first time in four years the church as a whole has gathered in person. The theme for the 2023 General Assembly gathering is "Kindom of God, Within Us, Among Us." As an act of worship and unity in celebration of the way God's expansive love connects each of us as "kin" and to each part of the larger kindom of God, Disciples of Christ churches from all over will share in this worship focus prior to gathering in Louisville.

I hope you will join us in worship on Sundays throughout June and July as we focus on who we are as Disciples of Christ, and how we participate in the Kindom of God, within us, and among us!
