The scriptures and stories from this year's Lenten season offer us narratives of Jesus encountering people who are **seeking**: Nicodemus comes to Jesus in the veil of night, Jesus approaches a Samaritan woman at a well, he heals a man born without sight. In these stories we can see glimpses of each person **seeking** a new beginning, a different life, a deeper faith. When each exchange unfolds with questions and exploration, a new unveiling also occurs – assumptions are disrupted, a new perspective, and the mystery of God's love is revealed in new ways.

Each week in the season of Lent, and through Holy Week, we will engage questions, leading to a deeper faith. Some questions might feel like a charge or a challenge; some might feel more hopeful or curious. The questions may not always lead to answers, but they can help us find clarity and a new perspective, all the while praying they will lead to new beginnings, restoration, and a wider grace.

Where are you headed? Palm Sunday and Processional
Matthew 21:1-11

As we read in scripture, this very first Palm Sunday processional was not a well planned out parade. As it came together organically, Jesus prepared his disciples to be questioned about what was happening, why they were taking him this colt, and who he was. Conversely, his disciples couldn't help but wonder where he was headed. Was he headed straight for his death? Join us for this special worship service as we examine the value of these questions this season, as we too wonder in the midst of opposing forces which way we will go. seeking: Thursday, April 6
Will you wash
my feet? Maundy Thursday
John 13:1-17, 31b-35

OPCC has been invited to join our sister congregation in south Overland Park, Hillcrest Christian Church, for Maundy Thursday worship. As they too have wondered about these holy questions, we will worship together as the disciples ask Jesus, "will you wash my feet?" Worship will begin in the Hillcrest Christian Church sanctuary (11411 Quivira Road, OP) at 7:00 p.m.



All are welcome to come to OPCC at 6:30pm for a special outdoors Good Friday Worship in the main Courtyard as we encounter Jesus and this day in a new way. Of all the questions in our series, this one remains the most unanswerable. Jesus' final lament gives voice to all those who have been forsaken those who suffer injustice, those who are abandoned. Instead of trying to answer this question with logic or theology, we are invited to live it and sit with it, just as Peter had to live with the questions he encountered around the fire on that fateful night so many years ago. Bring a camp chair if you are able, come as you are, and enjoy our outdoor fireplace, and additional firepit, in the large OPCC courtyard as we worship on this sacred day, together.



These are questions so many of us remember from scripture when Jesus, mysteriously appearing to Mary as the gardener, asks her: "Why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?" On this Easter morning, come ponder together who we are looking for? Why have we come to the tomb? What kind of resurrection are we looking for?

- Join us at 8:00 a.m. in the OPCC main courtyard for an outdoor "Sunrise" Service! You can leave your camp chairs on Good Friday, or we will also have chairs for everyone as we remember this amazing new day!
- Join us at 10:30 a.m. in-person or virtually to celebrate Christ's resurrection! Join for songs, scripture, and communion as we celebrate the resurrection of the Christ on the morning of the third day!

On your way into the sanctuary, please take note of our Wonder Wall! As a tool to open our minds and ask big questions grab a marker and write down *any* question you might have. It can be something light, or something hard to answer.

There are no bad questions!

It is important to remember when using the Wonder Wall that not all of our questions may have answers. Maybe there are no answers. Or maybe we just are not ready yet. And that's okay. The purpose of the Wonder Wall is not to get answers, it is to get you wondering, and seeking, so let us wonder, worship, and seek, together.

Property Commission

Activities for the past month:

- 1. Temperature Maintenance had to replace the high limit control to the boiler plus replaced a heating valve on one of the air handlers.
- 2. We are in the process of replacing our two different trash and recycling vendors (Rubicon and GFL). Going forward we will have one dumpster for trash and one dumpster for recycling and both will be emptied weekly. Hope to have the changeover done by the end of March.
- 3. State fire marshal is requiring OPCC to install a fire pull station within the Honey Bee rental area.
- 4. If you haven't been by the church in the last two weeks, when you come you will see that the construction of the new fire station across the street is about to get serious. The construction fencing has gone up and the construction trailer has been installed. As a reminder, parking can still take place on the East side of Conser, however, the passenger will have to navigate the rolled straw along the curb.
- 5. Property is currently installing new reserved parking signs in front of the church and at the North entrance, and another handicap sign at the West entrance. The West entrance is the only entrance that has a permanent ramp. The West and North entrances will be unlocked, along with the front entrance, every Sunday morning.
